

Group Visits 2016

The museum welcomes group visits from schools, Scouting/Guiding groups, other young people's groups and enthusiasts of all sorts.

Enjoy a great day out exploring our unique collection of military and civil aircraft and cockpit sections, together with indoor displays showcasing Norfolk's aviation history. School groups from primary school age upwards may like to plan a visit as part of their study of the Second World War, military history, engineering or the mechanics of flight.

Pre-booked groups will enjoy a free, hands-on guided tour inside one of our aircraft, normally our Nimrod MR2 maritime patrol aircraft or the Vulcan Cold War bomber.

Visits through the museum are self-guided, although volunteers are available to interpret exhibits and answer questions. Personalised tours or talks may be available by special request.

Facilities include free coach parking, toilets, a gift shop, and a tea room, which can double as a classroom. Hot and cold drinks and snacks are available for purchase. Groups are welcome to bring their own lunches to enjoy either indoors or at our outdoor picnic area, which offers views of aircraft flying from Norwich International Airport.

Please allow 2-4 hours for a full visit.

Admission rates are £3.30 per child (includes children under 8). Adults are responsible for children at all times during the visit. We recommend that one adult be in attendance for every five children, this adult will be admitted without charge. Admission for adult groups is charged at £6.50 per person or £6.00 for seniors (over 60) and students. We accept payment by cash, cheques or card. Cheques should be made payable to City of Norwich Aviation Museum.

Group visits may be held throughout the year, any time the museum is open. However, it is helpful if you are able to plan your visit for a Wednesday.
